Introduction

This policy statement sets out the school's arrangements for managing the access of providers to pupils at the school for the purpose of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. Currently the careers programme includes careers education sessions at key stage 3, whole day activities for key stage 4 and fortnightly PSHCE lessons with careers based enrichment sessions at key stage 5. These sessions include career guidance activities, information and research activities which will include an introduction to START Profile, Uexplore and merseyinteractive. This also enables students to develop individual career planning. Other sessions include making life choices, interview techniques and writing a CV. Careers lessons remain part of the school's PSHE programme. Other focused events, are Careers Convention, Mock Interviews and University/ HE / Alternative post-16 educational visits.

In addition to these programmed events, students can request a careers interview at any time with Marie Machin from Career Connect. Careers interviews are co-ordinated by Mr D Bell.

Premises and facilities

The school will make the main hall, classrooms or private meeting rooms available for discussions between the provider and students, as appropriate to the activity. The school will also make available AV and other specialist equipment to support provider presentations. This will all be discussed and agreed in advance of the visit with the Careers Leader or a member of their team.

Providers are welcome to leave a copy of their prospectus or other relevant course literature at the main school reception, which is managed by our office staff and will be passed onto our CIAG Coordinator who will make the resource available to our students.

Baker Clause, as from August 2022:

South Wirral has a responsibility to set students on the path that will secure the best outcome which will enable them to progress in education and work and give employers the highly skilled people they need. We act impartially, in line with their statutory duty or contractual requirement, and not show bias towards any route, be that academic or technical.
