Geography equips students with the ability to demonstrate knowledge of locations, places, processes, environments and different scales.

KS3 Geography encourages students to deepen their understanding of **geographical concepts and processes**. **Students will apply this knowledge to different geographical issues by using key geographical skills** such as interpreting a range of sources of geographical information, including maps, diagrams, globes, aerial photographs. Students communicate geographical information in a variety of ways, including through maps, numerical and quantitative skills and writing at length.
